For customers that have paid tuition for the full month of March, I will not be able to provide refunds. I hope you understand. We are planning on providing make-up classes.

Yesterday, you were notified that our art show has been canceled. It falls within the category of an event with 50 or more people attending which has been discouraged by Governor Holcomb. All students artwork will be returned along with a refund check. Since we are closing, you will be able to pick them up upon your return to classes in April at your studio.
